

**2020 SMALL RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
FAIR MARKET RENTAL RATES AND INCOME LIMITS**

These 2020 rates are in effect and will remain in effect until MDA releases new rates. Landlords must use these rate limits and may not charge rents in excess of the listed rates for all new leases.

These rates are the maximum rents that can be charged for this HUD assisted program. Landlords may charge lower rates.

The table below shows 2020 Small Rental Assistance Program rental rates for tenants with incomes at or below 80% and between 81% and 120% of the AMI. Please be aware that these rental rates may be subject to a downward or upward revision on a yearly basis depending on various factors.
