Disaster Damage:

Hurricane Katrina made land fall in Mississippi on August 29, 2005 and turned out to be the worst natural disaster to ever hit the United States. Damage along Mississippi's Gulf Coast was widespread and damage estimates were over \$125 billion dollars. FEMA reported 65,380 homes were damaged or destroyed and estimated 44 million cubic yards of debris in south Mississippi. The Mississippi Development Authority (MDA) has developed plans and programs to address disaster relief, long-term recovery and restoration of infrastructure.

Recovery Needs:

Recovery Needs: 1. Assistance to homeowners affected by the storm. 2. Assistance with fraud and abuse in connection with the rebuilding activities. 3. Assistance with code enforcement in the rebuilding process. 4. Assistance to Public Housing Authorities in providing affordable housing to low-income families. 5. Assistance with the rebuilding of public infrastructure such as water and sewer. 6. Ratepayer mitigation in order to protect residential and business customers from bearing the entire cost of the utility infrastructure restoration and rebuilding. 7. Wind Insurance Mitigation in order to maintain affordable insurance rates for the Mississippi Gulf Coast. 8. Programs to support economic development 9. Programs to increase the availability and affordability of small rental properties.

SUMMARY FOR 3rd QUARTER 2023 QPR:

1st allocation

Mississippi continues to make progress in the Katrina disaster recovery efforts in the third quarter of 2023.

Through the Homeowner's Assistance Program (HAP) \$2 billion have been disbursed to nearly 28,000 families. The Elevation Grant Program (EGP) has disbursed approximately \$37 million.

Under the Long-Term Workforce Housing (LTWH) initiative, grants and loans were made to for-profits, non-profits and local units of government to increase the availability of affordable housing. These projects have constructed and/or rehabilitated single- and multi-family housing, provided homebuyer assistance to eligible households, and provided loans to small developers. In addition, several projects provided public services and planning activities for LTWH and the Neighborhood Home Program (NHP). A total of 1,201 homeowners have been assisted through the homebuyer assistance (HBA) projects with expenditures totaling over \$78.4 million. In addition, 730 new construction units, 427 rehabilitation and 328 NHP rehab units have been completed.

The Public Housing Program allocated funds to coastal public housing authorities for the construction, repair and rehabilitation of low-income housing units damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. There are 18 projects in service providing 1,758 units, and all construction was completed. Total Public Housing units from Grant 1 and 2 are 1,833. All project funds have been disbursed as planned, and all activities are complete.

The Infrastructure grant program has completed the final stages of rebuilding the coast's water and wastewater infrastructure systems. The funds are administered by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) as well as the local entities awarded. All projects under this grant are closed. No construction is remaining.

Economic development projects are under way to restore the area's quality of life. As of September 30, 2023, the Economic Development program has awarded a total of 62 sub-grants with approximately \$332 million under contract. Fifty-six (56) projects have completed Katrina CDBG-funded construction. A total of 6,271 jobs are projected to be created, and 6,139 jobs have been created to date. In addition, 81 jobs were created by one (1) terminated project, bringing the total number of jobs created to date to 6,220. A total of 721 jobs were projected to be retained and were verified as retained as of the subgrant closeout dates. No projects were closed out during the reporting period. Fifty-four (54) completed projects and six (6) terminated projects had been closed out as of the end of the reporting period. No closeout packages are currently under review.

The Tourism Industry Restoration program awarded 28 sub-grants totaling approximately \$5 million. The sub-grant close-out process is complete, and close-outs have been executed for all 28 projects.

Progress continues the construction of Community Revitalization projects for the quarter ending September 30, 2023. All projects are in the six lower counties of Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, George, Stone and Pearl River, with the largest concentration of projects in the three coastal counties most impacted by the storm. Approximately \$327 million has been disbursed with 99 projects completed.

The Go Zone Revitalization Grants program provides funding for eligible CDBG community development activities in the 49 Presidential declared disaster counties, excluding the lower six counties of George, Harrison, Hancock, Jackson, Pearl River and Stone. The Go Zone program disbursed approximately \$56 million. Of the 43 grants awarded, all are complete and closed.

Mississippi Port Authority is working toward project close out. All CDBG funds have been fully expended. Total job creation to date is 1,432. Total LMI job creation to date is 1,118 (78%).



The Hancock County Long-Term Recovery or “Ground Zero” Program is designed to provide special assistance to this county, which suffered the most dramatic damage from Hurricane Katrina. The program funds locally conceived and prioritized projects designed to rebuild public infrastructure and revitalize the county’s economy, particularly recapturing the area’s pre-Katrina identity as a destination for regional tourism. As of September 30, 2023, the Hancock County Long-Term Recovery program has disbursed approximately \$159 million. Of the total 46 projects, 44 projects are complete and closed out, 1 project is complete and awaiting closeout and 1 project was cancelled/withdrawn.

Some activities in this QPR reflect drawdown amounts for the quarter that differ from the expense amounts for the quarter. These quarterly variances are due to timing between expenses as of the end of the quarter and drawdowns completed by the end of the quarter. Quarterly reconciliations support that the year-to-date expenses and revenue are correct, and that cumulative drawdowns do not exceed cumulative expenses.

Several activities have negative expenses for the quarter. These negative quarterly amounts are due to reimbursements for overpayments.

Please note that the overall benefit percentage requirement calculations in this QPR does not take into account waivers associated with this grant. Calculations including waivers indicate that this grant is projected at 60.13% to date and actual at 61.92% to date.

The end of the five-year compliance period for the final two loans that were awarded was December 31, 2022. The program expended \$2,965,555.97 of the \$2,967,099.81 KCDBG award amount. The balance of \$1,543.84 will be deobligated at closeout. The MDA-DRD compliance team reviewed all loans that were reported as successfully closed to determine whether all terms and conditions had been met, including job creation or retention, and provided a monitoring report to the HCCDF. The HCCDF submitted its draft interim response to the MDA-DRD on



December 1, 2020. The remaining compliance issues were resolved in the reporting quarter. MDA-DRD Compliance verified the creation of seventy-two (72) total jobs, with sixty-five (65) of those low/mod jobs, and the retention of six (6) total jobs, with three (3) of those LMI jobs. NOTE: Number of Persons Benefitting includes persons in Retained jobs as well as those in Created jobs. The HCCDF submitted closeout packages to MDA-DRD on April 5, 2023. Closeouts have been reviewed and final financial documents have been requested from the HCCDF. Upon receipt of those documents and release of the balance of the revolving loan fund to MDA-DRD, the subgrant will be closed out.

The company created 38.07 total jobs, eighteen (18) of which were LMI jobs; these numbers have been verified by MDA-DRD. The subgrant agreement expired on October 31, 2017. The project administrator prepared a budget modification to request an additional extension of the subgrant end date to allow sufficient time to complete the subgrant closeout process and draw down remaining funds. Draft copies of the modification, final Request for Cash, and closeout package were submitted to MDA-DRD in late August 2023. MDA-DRD provided comments to the administrator in September 2023. The revised versions of the documents will be provided to the Hancock County Board of Supervisors for approval in October 2023, after which they will be forwarded to MDA-DRD for approval and execution. Subgrant is expected to be closed out in the next quarter.

Katrina CDBG funded construction on the project began in January 2012 and completed in September 2015. The KCDBG scope of work is complete except for job creation. The subgrant agreement expired on June 30, 2017. In February 2018, MDA sent the County a Notice of Potential Non-Compliance stating that the project had not met the HUD National Objective of assisting LMI persons. In April 2019, the County sent a letter to the Developer outlining possible corrective actions for failure to fulfill subgrant terms and conditions. In Summer 2021, The Claiborne at Gulfport Senior Assisted Living Facility, projected to create 35-45 full-time equivalent (FTE) positions, completed construction and accepted its first residents in August 2021. The facility continues to provide certified payrolls and job applicant survey forms for new hires to the County and MDA for review. To date, the County and MDA-DRD have verified the creation of fifty-one (51) total FTE positions, with those positions filled by or made available to 136 LMI persons. Project has met its LMI commitment. [NOTE: The DRGR system will not allow Low and Mod Jobs to be greater than Total Jobs reported; thus, cumulative totals entered are 51 Total Jobs, 25 Low Jobs, and 26 Mod Jobs.] Additional FTE jobs and LMI new hires for The Claiborne will be reported to HUD as the County and MDA-DRD receive complete and correct paperwork and verify the numbers. Employee retention continues to plague The Claiborne, as is the case with the healthcare industry throughout



the country. The Developer provided the County with job applicant survey forms from Enhabit Home Health; however, many survey forms had incomplete or inaccurate information, and the payrolls did not contain sufficient data to document new hires. The County and the Developer requested revised documents but have not received them to date. Job creation for Enhabit will be reported if those documents are provided. The Mississippi Gulf Coast YMCA continues to express interest in building a new facility on the project site that would employ up to seventy (70) FTE workers and serve a large percentage of LMI individuals but to date has not secured funding. The Developer is in talks with other potential tenants but has not finalized those deals. Potential dates for building construction and job creation completion are unknown for those businesses. The County, Developer, and MDA held a project status meeting on September 21, 2021. The County developed a timeline and goals for the Developer, including placement of covenants on all parcels that benefitted from KCDBG funded improvements to require tenants to report on job creation to the Developer and County. On March 16, 2022, the County sent written notice to the Developer that the project had failed to comply with the milestones established in the timeline. The County advised the Developer that it was proceeding with a Notice of Intent to Default. The Developer's legal counsel submitted a written response to the County on March 25, 2022 to provide information not included in the quarterly report in the hope of addressing some of the County's concerns. The County has not provided further communication to MDA to date. In Fall 2022, the Developer hired Vallas Realty to promote and market Gulfport Highlands to prospective tenants.

MDA received a check in the amount of \$14,130.72 for the interest due and payable from June 1, 2020 to February 28, 2021. During the period of March 1-December 31, 2021 the Company made the regularly scheduled monthly interest payments of \$1,570.08. In January 2022, the Company began making payments of interest and principal consistent with the revised loan payment schedule. Payments continued during the



reporting period.

SUMMARY FOR 3rd QUARTER 2023 QPR:

2nd allocation

Mississippi continues to make progress in the Katrina disaster recovery efforts in the third quarter of 2023.

The Small Rental Assistance Program (SRAP) made forgivable loans available to small rental property owners. As of September 30, 2023, 3,509 units had completed construction and obtained certificates of occupancy. The properties are in various stages of completing periods of affordability.

Under the Long-Term Workforce Housing (LTWH) initiative, grants and loans were made to for-profits, non-profits and local units of government to increase the availability of affordable housing. These projects have constructed or rehabilitated single- and multi-family housing, transitional housing, and senior living developments for eligible households. A total of 4,317 Neighborhood Home Program (NHP) rehabilitation units, 237 LTWH rehab units and 221 new construction units have been completed.

This portion of the Public Housing Program allocated funds to coastal public housing authorities for the new construction of two projects consisting of 123 housing units to supplement PHA for properties damaged or destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. Development one opened successfully with 75 units, and development two, with a planned 48 units, did not proceed due to many significant roadblocks during the pre-development phase. Construction is complete, the program contract is closed out, and the one development of 75 units is continuing to provide low/moderate income households quality housing. All project funds have been disbursed, and all activities are complete.

The Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Assistance Fund, (TCAF), provides low-interest loans for the new construction of affordable housing to developments that were awarded Low-Income Housing Tax Credits through the Mississippi Home Corporation (MHC). Construction is complete, the program contract is closed out and all seven developments with a total of 618 units are serving low/moderate income households.

This portion of the Infrastructure grant program is providing improved water and wastewater infrastructure systems to coast



residents with low-moderate income. The funds are administered by the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) as well as the local entities awarded. All projects under this grant are closed. There is no construction remaining.

Summary of 3rd Quarter 2023 QPR

Hurricane Zeta

Mississippi continues to work on the Zeta disaster recovery efforts in the third quarter of 2023.

FEMA Match Infrastructure Program

On June 5-6, 2023, HUD representatives conducted technical assistance sessions with the MDA-DRD team in Jackson, MS. At the TA visit, MDA-DRD was informed that all FEMA Public Assistance (PA) projects, including those that were closed prior to the State’s CDBG-DR subgrant agreement with HUD for Hurricane Zeta funding, are required to comply with CDBG cross-cutting requirements. HUD advised DRD to request a waiver of the application of CDBG cross-cutting requirements to Mississippi’s FEMA Match Program.

On June 26, 2023, the MDA-DRD team held a Microsoft Teams meeting to discuss next steps for the program, including the preparation and submission of a waiver of the application of CDBG cross-cutting requirements to Mississippi’s FEMA Match Program.

On August 4, 2023, MDA-DRD submitted to HUD a request for guidance on labor standards not applying to FEMA PA projects that were completed before the execution of Mississippi’s grant agreement with HUD for Hurricane Zeta CDBG-DR funding and that CDBG-DR funds can be applied to those closed projects, OR, in the alternative, a request that HUD issue a waiver as to the application of labor standards to those FEMA PA projects that were completed before the State entered into a grant agreement with HUD for Hurricane Zeta CDBG-DR funding.

On August 29-30, 2023, FEMA Match Program Subrecipients and the MDA-DRD team attended HUD Office of Inspector General (OIG) Disaster Grantee Fraud Training in Biloxi, Mississippi. Topics covered included why fraud matters to grantees and subgrantees, conflict of interest, uniform administrative requirements, cost principles, and audit requirements, and antitrust conspiracies.

On September 6, 2023, MDA-DRD conducted a Teams meeting with the FEMA Match Program Subrecipients to discuss adjustment to the subgrant application process pending HUD’s response to the State’s waiver request as well as next steps for the program, including plans for a program implementation workshop.

Roof Repair & Retrofit Program



The subrecipient, Habitat for Humanity of the Mississippi Gulf Coast (HFHMG), has completed on-boarding activities with MDA-DR to include review and training in HUD CDBG-DR and MDA-DR policies and procedures. Internal subrecipient procedures for outreach, applicant intake and eligibility determination, and financial management and reporting have been developed. The process for securing subcontractors for program implementation (outreach, system of record development, damage estimation, construction, and inspection) is on-going by HFHMG.

Mississippi Center for Justice Fair Housing Education

The subrecipient, the Mississippi Center for Justice, has completed on-boarding activities with MDA-DR to include review and training in HUD CDBG-DR and MDA-DR policies and procedures. MCJ has developed educational materials (flyers and power point presentations) specific to Fair Housing, pre-launch information to assist potential RR&R program applicants, and heirship issues associated with CDBG-DR associated eligibility. MCJ is establishing partnerships with community-based and housing advocacy organizations for outreach and workshop sites.

Public Housing Authority

A subgrant agreement has been entered into between MDA-DR and the Biloxi Housing Authority (BHA) to harden senior housing property against future disasters and to assist in the rehabilitation of the BHA headquarters to a location outside a flood zone. Preliminary on-boarding activity with MDA-DR has begun and further training will occur in the upcoming quarter. Pending completion of environmental review requirements, BHA anticipates initiating procurement activity in the upcoming quarter for subcontractors required to undertake the planned activities.

Harrison County Sand Beach Mitigation Project

The program manager met with the grantee to discuss overall project and grant process. A new mitigation grant application was drafted and sent to grantee for completion. Once the application is received from the grantee, MDA will be able to draft the subrecipient agreement.

Mississippi Center for Justice has completed on-boarding activities with MDA-DR to include review and training in HUD CDBG-DR and MDA-DR policies and procedures. MCJ developed educational material specific to Fair Housing, pre-launch information to assist potential applicants, and heirship issues associated with eligibility. MCJ is continuing to establish partnerships with community based and housing advocacy organizations for outreach and workshop sites, and started the Fair Housing rollout. Heirs' property workshops have started and will continue scheduling and providing information.
